**Goal:** A registry designed to collect clinical patient data and perform analysis to drive improvements in both quality of care and functional outcomes for the limb loss and limb difference population in the US.

**Problem:** There is a lack of data on effective clinical practices and technologies to support and guide care providers and patients alike. Before the existence of the Limb Loss and Preservation Registry (LLPR) there was no method to gather data from the acquired and congenital limb loss or limb difference community

**Solution:** The LLPR is the first national Registry of its kind in the United States to standardize, collect, measure and report patient outcomes relative to limb loss or preservation surgery and post-surgical care and rehabilitation. This powerful tool propels a new era of personalized healthcare, where comprehensive data becomes valuable information, driving progress in the O&P industry

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
