Goal: To break down barriers in prosthesis provision and create a comprehensive, inclusive, and accessible program that can be widely adopted. We are looking to provide an equitable solution for amputees, creating a better future.

Problem: Of the 5.5 million amputees in the United States it is estimated 60% do not have access to prosthetic devices. Many issues contribute to this void, with a heavy dependence upon charity to provide devices.

Solution: Utilize virtual and continuous engagement methods to involve all stakeholders within the amputee community. With an aim to identify barriers faced by amputees, research existing opportunities, programs and advocacy efforts, and explore promising solutions. Enabling a comprehensive understanding of the size and scope of the challenge faced by amputees. Based on this understanding, we can then source solutions capable of addressing these issues at scale.
